


ABOUT 25-HOUR PASS

What is a 25-hour pass?

25-hour pass is a ticket that contains 25 1-hour tickets. When you first pass through the gate,1 hour will be subtracted from your IC lift ticket, leaving you with 24 hours remaining. From the time the hour was subtracted, you can pass through the gate as many times as you like. After that, the hour will be subtracted every hour in the same way, for a total of 25 hours.

*The 25-hour pass can only be used at Sapporo Teine.



For example if you first pass through the gate at 9:00 after purchasing, one hour will be deducted, and you will be able to pass through the gate until 9:59.

Since you may still be skiing at 10:00, if you pass through the gate again at 10:20, another hour will be deducted, and you will be able to pass through the gate until 11:19.

After skiing for the full hour from when you pass through the gate, no more hours will be deducted until you pass through the gate again, so you can take a leisurely lunch break during the time when you are not skiing.



Since you can ski in one-hour increments, you can use it for 5 hours x 5 times. For example, comparing it to a regular 5-hour pass...

- The hourly rate for a 25-hour pass is 1,000 yen
- If you use it for 5 hours a day, you can enjoy "5,000 yen x 5 times"!
- Compared to a 5-hour pass 6,000 JPY, 6,000 yen x 5 times = 30,000 JPY \rightarrow 5,000 JPY cheaper than a 25-hour pass (25,000 JPY)!
